
NIDCESSITY OF WISDOM IN WARRAGE



There are several things that you need to understand in marriage


1. Your marriage is your life.

2. Marriage will either increase you or reduce you.


3. Your marriage will either make you a happy person or a sad person.


4. Your marriage can complete your life or complicate it.
